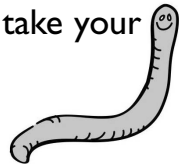

in the street, anyway.



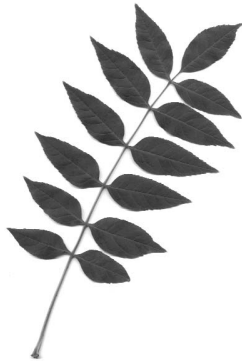

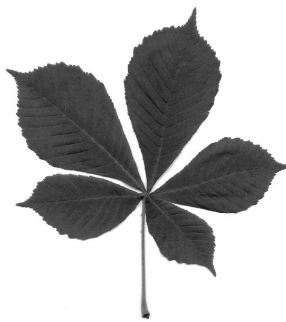
